Set Apart is a 9-month gap year program for young adults ages 18-26 that are focused on igniting their faith and impacting the world. Students grow in Discipleship, Leadership Training, and Missions as they learn from passionate instructors, gain practical and hands-on leadership skills through serving within the ministries of Destiny Church and sharing the gospel through evangelism. Set Apart's desire is to prepare students to be relevant leaders in their communities, churches and on the mission field.

DISCIPLESHP

Deepen your faith by interacting regularly with gifted teachers, engaging in small groups, and meeting weekly for one-on-one discipleship with a staff member.

LEADERSHIP

Strengthen and stretch your leadership skills by interning at our local church and by leading your peers on a variety of different outreaches and serving within the community.

MISSIONS

Make an impact in the lives of others by participating in a Missions trip. Every student will experience a missions trip during their time in Set Apart whether overseas or a local mission.

During this gap year program, you will engage in life-changing teachings, be intentionally discipled, and participate in a mission trip.

Who is Set Apart designed for?

Set Apart is designed for high school graduates ages 18-26 who desire a season committed to growing in their relationship with God. Through discipleship, leadership training, and missions, you will be challenged and encouraged to go deep and live life with God. We want you to discover your unique passions, giftings, and calling. We want to see God equip you to pursue those with excellence. Some of our students enter the program knowing they want to serve in full-time ministry and Set Apart provides a launching pad for their dreams. We also have students who are unsure about their future and come with an open heart. Set Apart allows them to draw close to God as they seek His plan for their life.

How is Set Apart different than college?

This is a season you intentionally set aside to focus on walking with God and learning more about Him. You will gain freedom and break strongholds off of your life. As you seek God, you will develop your strengths. Set Apart combines classroom time, group activities, small group times, and internships. You will apply what you are learning in practical ways. The goal of Set Apart is not to obtain a grade or a degree, but to focus on personal application and growth. A season in Set Apart will transform your heart and life.

When should I apply? What is the application process like?

We begin accepting applications in the spring and will take applications until mid August. After August, acceptance to Set Apart is conditional based on availability. We recommend applying by spring

or early summer because spots fill up and it's helpful to get a jump-start on support raising.

Once these required forms are submitted to Set Apart they will be reviewed by staff. You will be contacted for a brief interview to get to know you and determine if the program seems to be a fit for you.

After your interview and prayerful consideration, you will be notified if you have been accepted into the program.

Discipleship

Discipleship happens best when it's done within the context of shared experiences, which is why nearly everything we do is done in community! We'll play together, pray together, and process the many experiences we share in an atmosphere of mutual support and care. Throughout your Set Apart experience, you'll participate in a small group with other students who are in the program. This is the place where your relationships deepen, accountability happens, and where you'll be personally challenged to live out the things God is showing you. You'll also receive one-on-one mentoring from a staff member.

An essential part of the discipleship process you will experience in Set Apart comes through dynamic teachings. On an almost daily basis, you'll receive biblical teaching from pastors, guest speakers, missionaries, and business professionals who have a passion for Christ. These speakers will not only encourage and challenge you in your relationship with Christ, but also in your relationships with those around you. You'll grow in your understanding of who God is, who you are in Christ, and your role in the expansion of His Kingdom. Community

Community is a pretty big deal in Set Apart - you could say it's one of our foundational values! There is a strong focus on relational development within the Set Apart community. You'll develop relationships with other students and staff members.

Student Requirements

1. Must have a vehicle and car insurance.
2. Must have a part-time job.
3. A properly signed Set Apart Application, Code of Conduct Agreement, Liability Release, and Background Check.
4. Must uphold and follow the Core Values in the Set Apart Program.
4. Must memorize scripture and complete weekly Word Study weekly.
5. Must have a protected guaranteed quality prayer time daily.
6. Must have the heart of a servant.
7. Must maintain a no dating policy for the duration of the nine months of Set Apart.
8. Must relocate to a host family if fitting.
9. Must serve under the ministry of Destiny Church.
10. Must commit to graduate from the Set Apart Program. (Duration of 9 months)
12. Must not have any outstanding financial obligations.
13. Must have a personal Bible and journal.
15. Must adhere to the class schedule and be aware of the allowed time off for holidays.
16. Must be between the ages of 18-26.
17. Tuition of \$1500 due upon admission and is non-refundable.
18. Students may be randomly drug tested.
19. Must have a personal iPad or computer.

Code of Conduct

-The Set Apart student will not access inappropriate materials on websites, social media, phones or reading material. Neither shall there be posting of inappropriate materials on the above or any other media at any time.

-The Set Apart Student will abstain from every appearance of evil, let no corrupt communication proceed our of their mouth or engage in idle talk.

-The Set Apart Student views themselves as a “Temple of God” and shall refrain from alcohol, smoking, gambling, ungodly language, substance abuse or involvement in any inappropriate actions.

-The Set Apart Student is a steward of all that God have given and shall demonstrate wisdom by recording, handling, and protecting all monies gathered by fund raisers, offerings, sales of merchandise etc. Students must honor God in every financial situation.

-The Set Apart Student will study to show themselves approved unto God a workman that needs not to be ashamed rightly dividing the word of truth.

-The Set Apart Student must not compromise the integrity of Set Apart or Destiny Church Naples by engaging in any activity that will damage the reputation of either.

-The Set Apart Student will minister to their specific gender, (male to male and female to female), unless so directed by the Director of Set Apart or Pastor present.

-The Set Apart Student will develop an attitude of accountability to the administration, instructors, and leadership of both Set Apart and Destiny Church.
