

Matthew 6:33 “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

The kingdom is the theme of the New Testament.

Matthew 3:1-2 In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, 2 and saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!”

The beginning of the ministry of Jesus was characterized by preaching the kingdom message.

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

Acts 1:3 to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many

infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

Anywhere Jesus goes the Kingdom goes.

Luke 9:1 Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. 2 He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

The Kingdom message is a message of power.

Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

When the Kingdom comes demons leave,
fear dissipates and hopeless people find
hope!

Isaiah 8:18 Here am I and the children
whom the LORD has given me!
We are for signs and wonders in Israel
From the LORD of hosts, Who dwells in
Mount Zion.

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a Child is born,
Unto us a Son is given; And the
government will be upon His shoulder. And
His name will be called Wonderful,
Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father,
Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of His
government and peace There will be no
end,

Psalms 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul;
And all that is within me, bless His holy
name! 2 Bless the LORD, O my soul,

And forget not all His benefits:
3 Who forgives all your iniquities,
Who heals all your diseases,

Psalms 103:19 The LORD has established
His throne in heaven, And His kingdom
rules over all.

Matthew 24:14 “And this gospel of the
kingdom will be preached in all the world
as a witness to all the nations, and then the
end will come.

Matthew 16:1 Then the Pharisees and
Sadducees came, and testing Him asked
that He would show them a sign from
heaven. 2 He answered and said to them,
“When it is evening you say, ‘It will be fair
weather, for the sky is red’; 3 “and in the
morning, ‘It will be foul weather today, for
the sky is red and threatening.’ Hypocrites!
You know how to discern the face of the

sky, but you cannot discern the signs of the times. 4 “A wicked and adulterous generation seeks after a sign, and no sign shall be given to it except the sign of the prophet Jonah.” And He left them and departed.

We are not chasing miracles.
We are casing Jesus.

Jesus said signs and wonders would follow the believers that are chasing Him.

Mark 16:17 “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

Ephesians 5:1 Therefore be imitators of God as dear children.

Amplified “Therefore become imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father];”

Message “Watch what God does, and then you do it, like children who learn proper behavior from their parents.

Jesus was a miracle worker.

2 Corinthians 5:20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ’s behalf, be reconciled to God.

Summer of Miracles is about you and I becoming miracle minded.

Judges 6:13 Gideon said to Him, “O my lord, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all

His miracles which our fathers told us about,

We cannot impact the world without the Supernatural.

John 10:37 “If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me;

2 Corinthians 2:1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God. 2 For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified. 3 I was with you in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling. 4 And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, 5 that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.

Matthew 6:9“In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.10 Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.

Colossians 2:8 Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ.
9 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 10 and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

Mark 10:13 Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. 14 But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, “Let the little children come to Me,

and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God.

Matthew 12:9-13 Now when He had departed from there, He went into their synagogue. 10 And behold, there was a man who had a withered hand. And they asked Him, saying, “Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?” —that they might accuse Him. 11 Then He said to them, “What man is there among you who has one sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not lay hold of it and lift it out?

12 “Of how much more value then is a man than a sheep? Therefore it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath.” 13 Then He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand.” And he stretched it out, and it was restored as whole as the other.

Mark 2:1 And again He entered Capernaum after some days, and it was heard that He was in the house.

2 Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. 3 Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four men. 4 And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. 5 When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you."

We need the kind of Faith that gets Jesus attention.

Mark 5:21-42 Now when Jesus had crossed over again by boat to the other

side, a great multitude gathered to Him; and He was by the sea. 22 And behold, one of the rulers of the synagogue came, Jairus by name. And when he saw Him, he fell at His feet 23 and begged Him earnestly, saying, “My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live.” 24 So Jesus went with him, and a great multitude followed Him and thronged Him. 25 Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. 28 For she said, “If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well.” 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction.

30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, “Who touched My clothes?” 31 But His disciples said to Him, “You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, ‘Who touched Me?’” 32 And He looked around to see her who had done this thing. 33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. 34 And He said to her, “Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction.” 35 While He was still speaking, some came from the ruler of the synagogue’s house who said, “Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?” 36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, “Do not be afraid; only believe.” 37 And He permitted no one to follow Him except Peter, James,

and John the brother of James. 38 Then He came to the house of the ruler of the synagogue, and saw a tumult and those who wept and wailed loudly.

39 When He came in, He said to them, “Why make this commotion and weep? The child is not dead, but sleeping.” 40 And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those who were with Him, and entered where the child was lying. 41 Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, “Talitha, cumi,” which is translated, “Little girl, I say to you, arise.” 42 Immediately the girl arose and walked, for she was twelve years of age. And they were overcome with great amazement.

4 Ways To Positioned Yourself for a Miracle

1. Prepared yourself mentally and physically. (Faith prepares)

Mark 5:28 For she thought to herself, “If I can just touch his robe, I will be healed.”

2. Positioned yourself in proximity to His presence.

Mark 5:27 “She had heard about Jesus, so she came up behind him through the crowd. “

3. Pressed pass your fear.

Mark 5:33 Then the frightened woman, trembling at the realization of what had happened to her, came and fell to her knees

4. Reached out for the Living Word

Mark 6:56 (AMP) And wherever He came into villages, or cities, or the countryside, they were laying the sick in the market places and pleading with Him [to allow them] just to touch the fringe (tassel with a blue cord) of His robe; and all who touched it were healed.

Jeremiah 33:6 Behold, I will bring health and healing, and I will heal them and reveal to them abundance of prosperity and security.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his stripes we are healed.

1 Peter 2:24 He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.

Psalm 103:2-4 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy,

James 5:14-15 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the leaders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well.

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved, for you are my praise.

Psalm 103:2-3 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives

all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases,

Acts 4:30 “And now, O Lord... Stretch out your hand with healing power; may miraculous signs and wonders be done through the name of your holy servant Jesus.”

Get miracle minded!
