Life is short, eternity is real and people matter most!

Favor is aligning our life with God's blessing and grace that positions us for increased influence, supernatural turnarounds, limitations broken, dreams awakened, missed opportunities redeemed and wide open new doors of divine possibilities.

2022 is a year of DIVINE FAVOR.

James 4:8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Jeremiah 29:12 Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen

to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you," declares the LORD

We believe when we give God the first and the best His divine favor follows.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Favor is not achieved its received.

Favor in the biblical concept means that God actually turns toward you.

When we position ourselves for favor we will experience ONLY GOD moments.

2 Kings 4:1-7 A certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets cried out to Elisha, saying, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the LORD. And the creditor is coming to take my two sons to be his slaves." 2 So Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil." 3 Then he said, "Go, borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbors—empty vessels; do not gather just a few. 4 "And when you have come in, you shall shut the door behind you and your sons; then pour it into all those vessels, and set aside the full ones."5 So she went from him and shut the door behind her and her sons, who brought the vessels to her; and she poured it out. 6 Now it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said to her son, "Bring

me another vessel." And he said to her, "There is not another vessel." So the oil ceased. 7 Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debt; and you and your sons live on the rest."

This was an only God moment!

This woman was desperate help.

3 questions to ask yourself when you need an only God moment.

1. Where does your desperation drive you?

2 Chronicles 20:1 It happened after this that the people of Moab with the people of Ammon, and others with them besides the Ammonites, came to battle against Jehoshaphat. 2 Then some came and told

Jehoshaphat, saying, "A great multitude is coming against you from beyond the sea, from Syria; and they are in Hazazon Tamar" (which is En Gedi). 3 And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. 4 So Judah gathered together to ask help from the LORD; and from all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.

17 'You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the LORD, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!' Do not fear or be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them, for the LORD is with you."

Jehoshaphat's default mechanism in trouble was to fall completely upon the grace and mercy of Jehovah God.

Where does your desperation drive you?

Fasting is a self imposed intentional desperation for God.

Psalms 35:13 But as for me, when they were sick, My clothing was sackcloth; I humbled myself with fasting;

Do you know what the biggest enemy of your spiritual growth and maturity is?

It's you, it's the old nature,

Paul said I die daily.

When we fast we put to death selfish ambition.

When we fast we humble ourselves and position our lives for Only God moments.

The widow woman's desperation drove her to God.

2. What is your house?

What is your "nothing, except..." that you can bring to God?

2 Kings 4: 2 So Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil."

The only God moment in your life is directly connected to something that is already in your house.

Something you already possess.

It's about simple faith being connected to the miracle.

God wants to get you involved in the miracle.

3. What is your ridiculous moment that will release the miraculous?

There is this feature about God where He uses the ridiculous to release the miraculous.

When you step over the line and are willing to do the ridiculous God will release the miraculous.

We are called into the supernatural. We are not called to live comfortable.

Use what God has put in your hand to glorify him and you will experience only God moments.

2 Kings 4:6 Now it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said to her son, "Bring me another vessel." And he said to

her, "There is not another vessel." So the oil ceased.

As long as there were available vessels the miracle never stoped.

2 Corinthians 4:6-7 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

Many of you are here but your not available.

Revival comes when the church is full of empty vessel's ready to be filled.
Revival comes when we are willing to do the ridiculous.
